A few things to make your moving experience a little easier:

1. Submit a water/sewer/trash service application with a \$120.00 deposit to the Town Office, if renting a copy of your rental agreement is also required.
 - a. You will be receiving a monthly water/sewer bill, via mail. Payment can be made at the Town Office, the drop box outside the Town Office, or by mail.
 - b. Payment is due by the 15th of each month.
 - c. Late charges will be accessed on the 16th of each month.
 - d. Additional fees are applied on the 20th; see back of bill for more details.
2. You have 30 days to have your driver's license address changed and your garaged area to the Town of Victoria. This can be done online or at any full service DMV (Department of Motor Vehicles). The closest full service DMV's are located in Farmville and South Hill, Virginia.
3. A Town sticker is required within 30 days of your move. It can be purchased at the Town Office.
4. The Town Office does offer DMV Select services for your convenience.
 - a. **DMV Selects do not issue Driver's Licenses, Learners Permits or Identification Cards.**
 - b. Vehicle Titles and Registrations
 - c. License Plates
 - d. Permits and Placards
 - e. Transcript Requests
 - f. Voter Registration Applications
 - g. Online services are available at DMVnow.com
5. Real Estate and Personal Property taxes are due December 10. Payment can be made at the Town Office or by mail.
 - a. **NOTE:** Real Estate and Personal Property taxes are also paid to *Lunenburg County twice a year. In June and again in December.*
6. Trash needs to be put out by 7:00 a.m. to insure prompt pickup.
 - a. Trash pickup for the East side of town (from Main Street to Lunenburg Correctional Center), will be Monday's.
 - b. Trash pickup for the West side of town (from Old Court Street to Steps), will be Tuesday's.

If a Holiday falls on Monday or Tuesday, the trash will be picked up the next day.
Occasionally adjustments have to be made to the pickup schedule. We apology for this inconvenience, every effort will be made to keep this to a minimum.
7. Free sign up for CODE RED Weather Warning System, use the link found on the Town of Victoria's website at www.victoriava.net under the Town Services tab.
